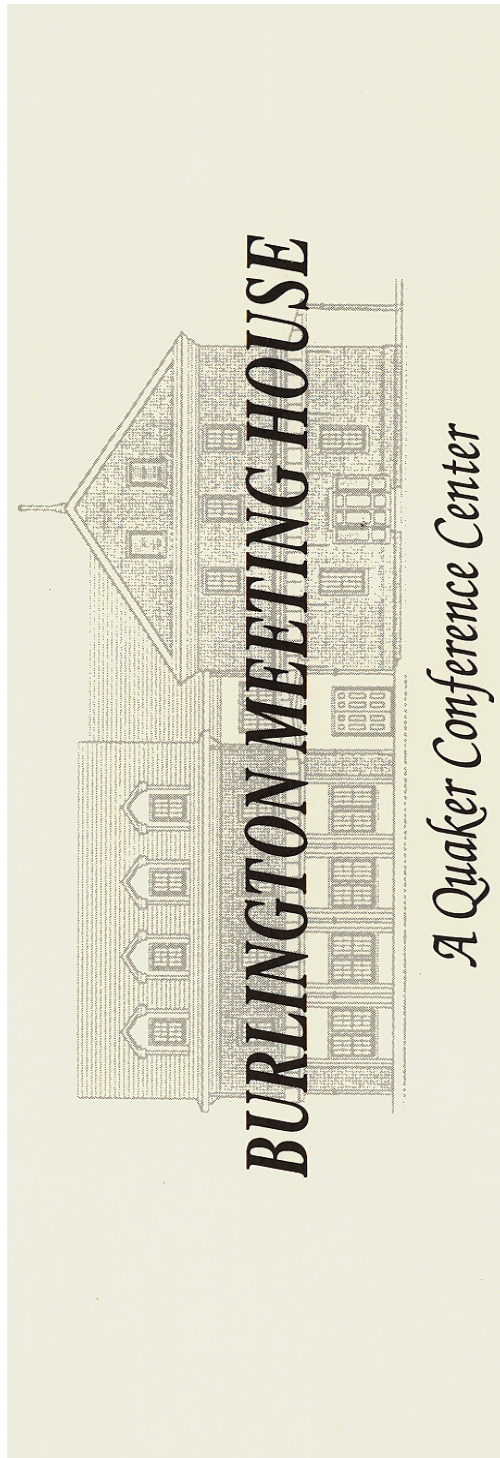

Accommodations

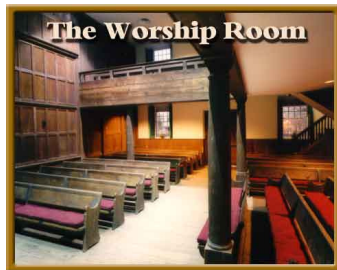
Flexible spaces for groups of up to 200 for day use or 88 for overnight use.



Two floors are dedicated to dormitory facilities which can sleep a total of 88 overnight guests. The rooms are partitioned into semi-

private spaces. Bathrooms and showers are found on each floor.

The 1783 meeting room is well suited for worship or presentations, lectures and performance art. Up to 200 can gather in this space rich in Quaker history and simplicity.



Designed for lectures, presentations, or performance arts in an amphitheater setting. This unique area can accommodate 100.



A multi-purpose room that can accommodate up to 125 people for meals or meetings, lectures or church services. The windows provide a view of the park-like burial ground which includes the burial site of Chief Ockanickon and founders of Burlington.



The modern commercial kitchen is available for use. A list of recommended caterers is also available.

Ever since early Quakers landed on the banks of the Delaware in 1677 and made friends with the Lenapi people, Burlington has been a site for special gatherings.

Today Burlington Meeting House & Conference Center consists of the renovated 1783 Meeting House and a modern addition, set on an attractive and tranquil parcel of land. The entire facility is fully ADA handicapped accessible.

In the historic district of Burlington, you can walk along the Delaware River, visit sites of historic interest and enjoy the local shops and restaurants close to the Meeting House.

The Meeting House is located in historic downtown Burlington NJ

-  5 minutes from the Burlington-Bristol Bridge
-  10 minutes from the PA-NJ Turnpike Bridge, I-95, I-295, and the NJ Turnpike
